In 1972, as a relatively new player to the Sport, Tom Harris was instrumental in the organizational planning and hosting of the first California Cup Tournament in Southern California. A long time resident of Thousand Oaks he has participated every year as a player, planner, umpire, coach, venue groundskeeper, games scheduler, and acted as Public Relations liaison for the media. Having retired from Moorpark College after 28 years as an engineering technology professor, Mr. Harris is still active in Harris Construction Corporation as a structural engineer. Billie Ahluwalia – Chair



Billie is the newly elected Chair for the tournament. He has served for ten years as Director of Finance for the tournament and is an active Board Director with responsibilities in the Finance Committee of the United States Field Hockey Association.

History

The Story of California Cup An International Field Hockey Tournament

Every Memorial Weekend, the Field Hockey Federation stages an international tournament at Moorpark College and in secondary venues as California Lutheran University and Moorpark Park and Recreation.

The tournament offers an outstanding four day opportunity to introduce families to the enjoyment of Field Hockey and to share all the experiences offered by the Los Angeles and surrounding areas. The tournament has grown over the years...

In 1972 – The first tournament successfully included the participation of six Men teams, five from the West Coast of US and one specially invited team from Germany.

In 1992 –The tournament included 13 divisions ranging from Under 9 children's teams to Over 40 for both women and men. A 30 feet long vendor tent and 6 Medical Stations added comfort to all participants. Each player on the top three teams for all divisions were awarded with gold, silver or bronze medals distributed in an Olympic style closing ceremony.

In 2002 – Participation grew to 140 teams, including squads of men, women, boys and girls. This tournament contributes more than \$ 5 M to the local economy. International competition includes the participation of top level teams from Spain, Canada, Argentina, Barbados, Mexico, Chinese Tai Pei, Dominican Republic and USA National.

In 2008 - The 37th edition featured 1,800 players .Tournament Committee approved the use of one new location with two Fields at California Lutheran University where 38 Under -19 teams compete in six pools; and 23 Under 16 teams in four pools.

Main venue and final games are played at Moorpark College. Prizes are awarded to all first, second and third place teams in the form of gold, silver and bronze medals and a US\$ 5,000 cash award to the Super Division first place winner for both Women and Men categories. Tournament results and news are featured in the Ventura County Star and in the Los Angeles Times.
